**Sunday 7 March**

Reading: Psalm 78:1-13

**Monday 8 March**

Reading: Mark 11:1-11

**Tuesday 9 March**

Reading: Mark 11:12-25

**Wednesday 10 March**

Reading: Mark 11:27-33

Prayers: Pray for all who work in the NHS, our local surgeries and Queen Margaret Hospital, the hospital chaplain and the need for helpers at the Sunday services.

**Thursday 11 March**

Reading: Mark 12:1-12

Prayers: Pray for our Primary School, for the children in nursery and school, the teachers and staff and the community activities that take place.
