RETIREMENT OF OUR MINISTER

Today is our final service with Norman. He is retiring after more than 35 years at Cairneyhill linked with Limekilns and we wish him and Karen a long and happy retirement. We will be marking the occasion both after this service and at an Afternoon Tea event this afternoon (for those who have booked their place).

NEW ARRANGEMENTS FOR SUNDAY SERVICES

Following Norman's retirement we will not be able to start the process of finding a new minister until the planned Union with Limekilns and Culross & Torryburn Churches can go ahead. In the meantime we will remain in linkage with Limekilns Church and we have agreed with Limekilns that we will hold joint services every week starting **from Sunday 3rd May. Services will all take place at 10:30 am** and will be held in Cairneyhill and Limekilns alternately. **We will meet in Cairneyhill on the 1st and 3rd Sundays of each month and in Limekilns on the 2nd and 4th Sundays.** Where there is a 5th Sunday (in May, August and November this year) services will be in Limekilns or Cairneyhill alternately. A full schedule of the relative dates and venues will be provided. Everyone is encouraged to travel to Limekilns when the service is taking place there, and car sharing is recommended. We will have visiting preachers to lead worship on certain Sundays and our Worship Teams will also be involved. Services will also continue be streamed and available to view online either live or as a recording.
